CSF TRANSPORTATION BULLETIN –

Transportation registration will be open from <u>May 1st to July 15, 2025.</u>

The registration link will be sent on May 1st in the annual letter from the Secretary-Treasurer.

We remind parents that they must register their children for the school transportation service <u>EVERY YEAR</u>.

Families who complete the registration before July 15, 2025, will receive information about the bus stop and pickup/drop-off times during the week before the school year starts.

The CSF has entrusted several transportation providers with the management of over 170 bus routes to ensure school transportation for students enrolled in its schools across British Columbia.

An annual review of the routes is conducted to adjust services based on demographic changes. These routes are established based on registrations received before July 15 of the current year.

In accordance with walking distance protocols, we inform you that the transportation providers must comply with and apply the walking distances defined in DA-1001. Some providers may need to make a stop up to the maximum walking distance. In such cases, students will need to get to the designated stop on their own.

REMINDER

Parents can use the online form to request the addition of a stop at a second address for shared custody or an authorized childcare service, provided that it does not modify or lengthen the existing route.

A secondary stop is NOT intended for dance, music, arts, or other extracurricular activities.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Please note that the walking zone varies based on the school level, the school, and the region.

To find your walking zone, consult the administrative guidelines DA-1001 § 9.

Use Google Maps to check if your address is within the walking zone or if you are eligible for school transportation.
